INVALIDIS RESULTS

The development of the Invalidis project has led to a series of new actions in relation to IAS, such as:



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- ❑ **2019.** Increase in the budget for IAS control of the “Biotrans” project (O620_BIOTRANS_4_E “Integrated Management of Biodiversity in the Cross-Border Area) from €150,000 to €500,000, within the Cross border cooperation Spain – Portugal Program.

- ❑ **2020/21.** Increase in IAS control and eradication actions (American mink, Florida tortoise, Azolla, Ludwigia, Mimosa, Ailanto...)

- ❑ **2021.** Regional Decree approval and publication of three control and eradication protocols for the species Mimosa, Ailanto, Florida Tortoise and Asian Hornet (<http://doe.juntaex.es/pdfs/doe/2021/870o/21050067.pdf>) .

Action 1.- Introduction of new lines of action in political instruments. Currently under negotiation with the European Commission.



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- **Objective 1.-** Inclusion of a new thematic Objective, within the priority axes of the European Regional Development Fund - ERDF.
- **Objective 2.-** Inclusion of new actions within the strategies of the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development - EAFRD
- **Objective 3.-** Inclusion of sub-measures within the measures established in the Participatory Local Development of LEADER

CURRENT SITUATION

PAC 2023 - 2027 (Approved on 8/31/2022, C.E.)

For the development of the same (Strategic Plan of the Common Agricultural Policy - CAP-SPCAP), **18 Decrees and a Law are being developed**, which must be approved in 2022, so that the CAP enters into force on January 1, 2023.

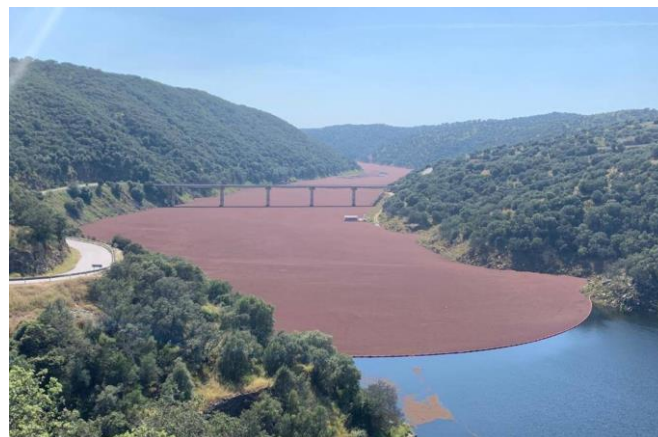
In Damage Restoration, specific mention is made of IAS, in risk assessment (p. 2072)

➤ Objective 1. Actions to develop with public entities

Activities with the Province Councils of the cities of Cáceres and Badajoz.

➤ Objective 2. Creation of provincial entities

Creation of an intercommunication body between the regional government of Extremadura and Provincial Councils, for the transfer of information.

➤ Objective 3.- Collaboration with Fempex

A municipal mandatory rule has been implemented on ISS. It is pending to be approved by the Extremadura consistories.

➤ Objective 4.- Implication of the regional administration with the project

Come into force agreements (112 Emergency Phone number), Protocols, Information network, Agreements with Environmental Agents.



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➤ **Objective 5.- Creation of a committee of experts**

Work is being done between the National Ministry of Ecological Transition and Demographic Population - MITECO and University of Extremadura.

➤ **Objective 6.- Establish coordination between entities**

Developed an agreement with the Extremadura Fire Stations to work on *Vespa velutina*.

➤ **Objective 7.- Promote public research related to IAS**



Coordination with the Hydrographic Confederation of the Guadiana River -CHG, in the control and eradication study of *Nymphaea mexicana* in Badajoz.



Work continues on the development of these objectives, perceiving good results.

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
